### NEW SHOOT TO RETRIEVE SPORT—BANGO DEMONSTRATION APRIL 25 & 26

Chuck Atchley passes on the following Shoot To Retrieve event to be held at the Chilhowee Sportsmen's Club, Hwy 129, Punkin Center, Maryville, TN. BanGo is similar to clay target s. A launcher made by Bumper Boy tosses a balloon attached to a synthetic bird for the gunner to hit and dog to retrieve. The bird when hit explodes in the air releasing feathers. Dogs must be steady until released by judges, but e-collars and leashes may be used. 10-minute timed series with shortest total time winning a prize. The event is held in coordination with Cure Finders, a cystic fibrosis charity. Open to all breeds.

### E. Collar Conditioning-Procedure

- 1. First nick on sit in the remote position
- After sit is stable and understood, here will be the next command enforced with a nick
- 3. Then heel by each side
- Once commands are understood, nick occasionally on two commands in the same sequence
- 5. D-bolt
- 6. Whistle introduction with commands
- 7. Collar fetch: walking fetch as done previously substituting

### F. Pile Work

- 1. Force to pile
  - a. identify. pile @ 20-25 yards away
  - b. remote sends to pile
  - c. Stick fetch to pile (still remote)
  - d. force with collar (still remote)
  - c. side sends (left & right heel)
- 2. Sit to pile
- 3. Come in from pile

### G. Double T

- In a different location than your pile before, ID double T pile for a few days
- 2. From halfway send from remote position
- 3. Force from remote position from half way
- 4. Force from full length
- 5. Sit to DT pile
- 6. Come in from DT pile
- 7. Teach long overs one at a time
- 8. Send many times to back pile mixing in a few long overs
- 9. Teach short overs
- 10. Mix all together with a majority of your sends to the back pile
- On the return (with bumper in mouth, stop and handle to an over pile and than the back pile
